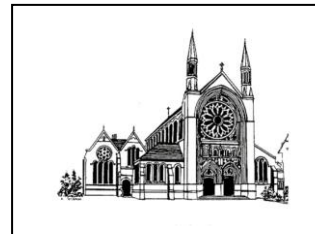

Pastoral Council: At our recent meeting we basically updated on recent activities and plans. We shared ideas on how to develop the Welcome Ministry in the Parish. Youth Ministry is continuing to develop and a decent sized group has become established. It was decided to cancel the Spring Social that had been planned. Our Social Outreach continues to develop: there has been a good response to the appeal for men's clothes and toiletries for the Olive Branch. We have now opened a bank account for our Cambodia link and shortly will offer opportunities for people to contribute on a regular basis. The July Coffee mornings will support our friends in Cambodia. Ramps are to be installed between Church and the Guild Room; these will be funded by a private donation and the Diocesan Commercial Company and should be in place in time for the Mass for the Sick and Housebound.
