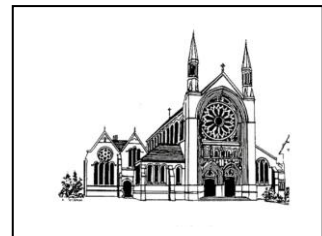

After next weekend's Masses there will be a **Retiring Collection** for the Day for Life.

On **Sunday 16th June** at **3pm** Bishop Mark will lead the third **Pause for Hope** service to be held in Saint Columba's church in Chester (Plas Newton Lane CH2 1SA). Pause for Hope is an ecumenical service offering all those affected by cancer a chance to come together in a spirit of prayer. It is an opportunity to pray for those living with cancer, for loved ones, carers, doctors, nurses and those scientists searching for a cure for cancer. The service is open to everyone and will include a reflection by Lynne Moorhead from the Hospice of the Good Shepherd. Following the time of prayer there will be refreshments in the parish centre.
