Fr. Martin writes: Many thanks to all who were able to join us for my Induction Mass on Tuesday. It was heartwarming to see many parishioners from across our three parishes. It was indeed an uplifting celebration and a good inauguration of our collaborative ministry. May St. Martin de Pores and St. Winifride, whose feast days we celebrated at that Mass, intercede for us. May I invite us all to please unite to carry one another along as one big family through the lockdown (which I call a retreat) period. Join us every morning for the live-streamed Eucharistic adoration and Mass.



Suspension of Public Worship until 2nd December: During this health emergency the celebration of Mass on Sundays, Holy Days and weekdays will continue to take place without a public congregation, and you are encouraged to unite yourself spiritually to the daily offering Mass. This might be helped by participating in the live streaming of the Holy Mass, following its prayers at home and making an act of Spiritual Communion. St. Thomas Aquinas described this act of Spiritual Communion as “an ardent desire to receive Jesus in the Holy Sacrament and a loving embrace as though we had already received Him.”

An Act of Spiritual Communion:

My Jesus,
I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament.
I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul.
Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart.
I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You.
Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.



You may also wish to join me in praying these **prayers for those affected:**

Merciful God, come to the help of your people.
Be our shelter in this time of peril and strengthen the bonds of our community. Bring healing to all who suffer
the ravages of disease and assist those whose skill and art can put an end to this affliction.
Through Christ our Lord. Amen.

Be with your people in this time of danger: bring strength to the afflicted and protection to those untouched by disease.
